First Charlotte Physicians leases EpiCentre space

First Charlotte Physicians has leased 13,500 square feet at the EpiCentre mixed-use project under construction at East Trade and South College streets.

The practice serves as both primary care physicians and providers of routine health care for acute and chronic illnesses in patients aged 16 and up.

The group will relocate from Founders Hall this summer.

Financial terms weren't disclosed.

The Ghazi Co. is developing the EpiCentre, a \$100 million, 53-story residential tower and entertainment complex at the 3.2-acre site of the former Charlotte Convention Center.

The uptown project, which Ghazi is pursuing as a joint venture with Flaherty & Collins of Indianapolis, will feature a mix of condos, restaurants, offices and shops, as well as a 175-room hotel.
